The purpose being was to provide additional security and educational facilities that were not within the remit of the schools educational system funding

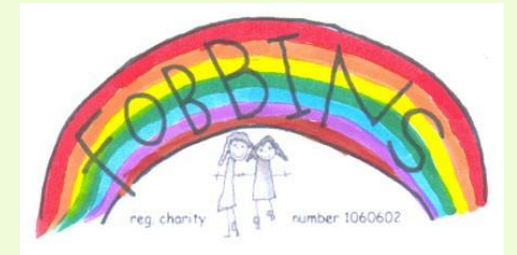


Registered Charity

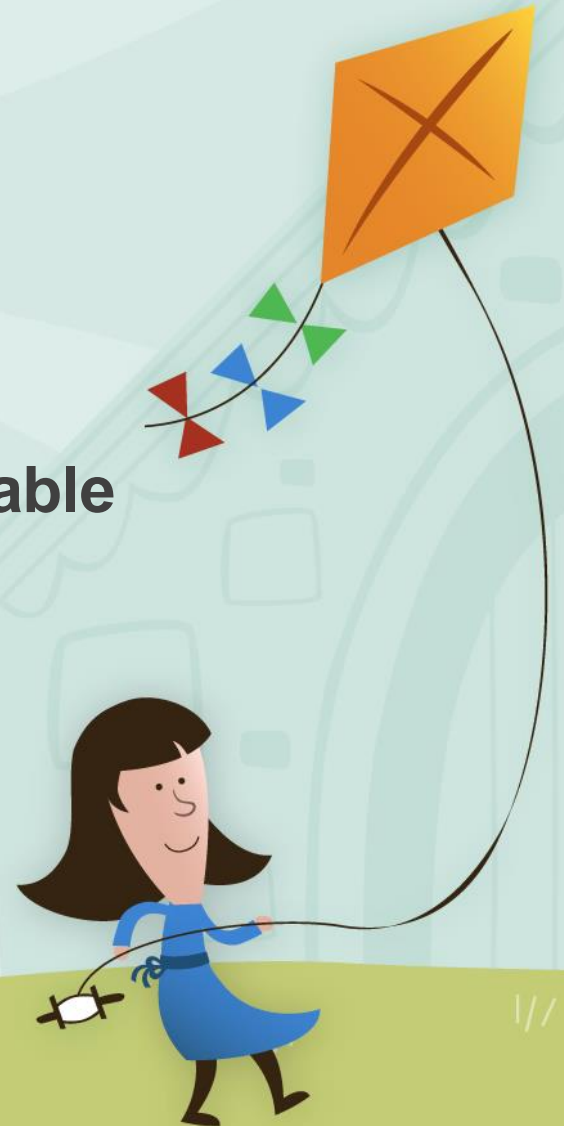


How Much Do We Raise ?

Each year is different!

- Bad years have been as low as £5,000
- Good years are as high as £9,000

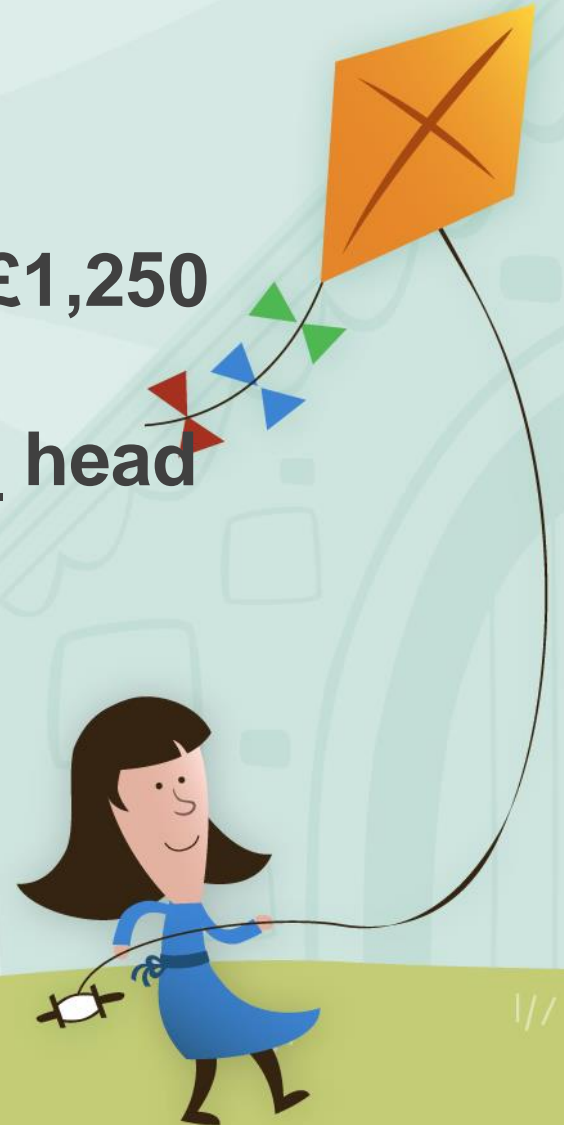
In 2012 / 2013 we raised £7,000 and we were delighted to be able to give each head teacher a cheque for £3,500



What About This Year?

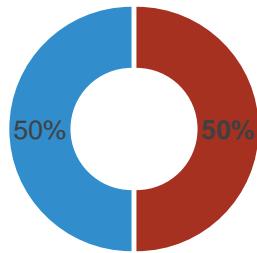
School Year Sept 2013 / July 2014

- Dec 2013 each head teacher received a cheque for £1,250
- July 2014 we were delighted to be able to give each head teacher a cheque for £2,000



How is the money divided?

All the money raised is paid into the FOBBINS Bank Account and shared equally between both schools



How is the Money Spent?

Each Head Teacher spends the money towards playground improvements and providing items that are not within the remit of the schools educational system funding
