Purposes – Aims and Objectives

- Inform you at an early stage of any concerns we may have and be available to discuss any concerns you may have

- Be welcoming and approachable
- Ensure all Y3 children are given a home agreement form at the beginning of the school year. The agreement will last throughout their time at Brook House.

Parents – We/I will aim to;

- Support the school in the standards it seeks to achieve by supporting school policies and rules
- See that my child arrives at school on time (8:55 a.m.) and is collected on time (3:20 p.m.)
- Send my child to school dressed according to school guidelines and equipped with P.E. kit
- Support the school in maintaining high standards of behaviour
- Encourage my child with any work done at home and to bring homework back on time
- Attend parents' meetings to discuss my child's progress – Two formal, Autumn/Spring, optional Summer Term open afternoon
- Let staff know of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning.
